### Role:

- Furniture fabrication using in-house tools inclusive of: manual lathe, panel saw, table saw, band saw, jointer, drill press, etc. under the guidance of our Senior Woodworker
- Sanding of all wood/metal furniture & lighting parts to finish-level quality prior to staining/lacquering
- Prepping of steel and aluminum lighting parts for plating/anodizing (as needed)
- Working across mediums and with various materials, including (but not limited to): wood, brass, steel, leather/suede, glass, mirror, stone, etc.
- Expected to help systematize continuous improvements and improve build standards
- Cleaning, polishing and preparing of finished works for packaging
- Wrapping and crating of pieces for shipment. Manage both incoming goods and outgoing deliveries. Inspect & reject any materials that do not meet MF standards
- Assist in better organizing and streamlining our studios production and output
- Sit in on our weekly studio production meetings to ensure projects keep on schedule

### Who You Are:

- 1-3 years experience in the furniture fabrication or product-build industry preferred
- Must be able to take direction, be organized, and switch gears quickly to meet the demands of production which come from working from a live schedule
- Ability to read, understand and work from drawings (and recommend improvements)
- Problem solving skills for working through fabrication roadblocks on projects that may have a unique customization, atypical material and/or construction complications
- Time management skills are critical, as is a strong attention to high-quality detail
- A serious interest in efficiency and the way things are made. Solutions-orientated
- A person who can handle several concurrent projects and shifts in priority
- Someone willing to wear multiple hats (We all do)
- An aptitude for learning new tasks and developing new skills is a must
- Must take pride in their work. Be reliable, collaborative, and communicative in a small team setting, while contributing to the overall motivation of the team
- Knowledge of various woodworking methods, machinery & safety measures
